Common Prefix	Tribal Designator This designates some ancient tribal origin to early tribal groups.  <i>ex. Ul refers to Wulgaru who are now considered a giant race who live in caves notorious for taking members of the wallara tribes as food in punishment - the chief wulgaru is guardian of the dead; Dj refers to a little people known as the Podji-Podji (size of children/babies) who live in trees behind doors of Bark and teach children about bush-tucker.</i>	Suffix
